### **ITEMS OF INTEREST**

1. The City is developing a five-year action plan to guide our ongoing work related to Tacoma's local environment. Staff from the City and other local organizations have been working to identify meaningful actions to address environmental issues, such as: transportation, recycling, energy use, green space, and improving livability across Tacoma. The Office of Environmental Policy and Sustainability provides the attached flyer related to the December 7<sup>th</sup> Climate Policy and Environmental Action in Tacoma Open House.

## STUDY SESSION/WORK SESSION

 The City Council Study Session of Tuesday, December 8, 2015, will be held in Room 16 of the Tacoma Municipal Building North, at Noon. Discussion items will be: (1) Veterans Internship Program (VIP); (2) Lincoln District Revitalization Program Update; (3) Other Items of Interest; (4) Committee Reports; (5) Agenda Review and City Manager's Weekly Report; and, (6) Executive Session – Potential Litigation.

At Tuesday's Study Session, City Manager's Office and Human Resources Department staff will provide a **briefing and update on the launch of the City's new Veterans Internship Program (VIP)**, which will include an overview of how this program will assist service members seeking to transition into the civilian workforce. Recent initiatives to strengthen our recruitment efforts of Joint Base Lewis-McChord (JBLM) service members will also be discussed in the briefing.

As a second item at Tuesday's Study session, Community and Economic Development (CED) Department staff will provide a presentation on the Lincoln District Revitalization Program. The presentation will include an update on the kickoff, Lincoln District Office, CED Business Liaison, Streetscape Project, Public Art, and programmatic coordination.
