

RESOLUTION NO. 38924

A RESOLUTION related to surplus property; approving the sale of approximately 13.06 acres of property located off of Howe Road in Lewis County, owned by the Department of Public Utilities, Power Division (d.b.a. "Tacoma Power") and now surplus to its needs, to Mr. David Filla for the negotiated price of \$160,515.

WHEREAS the City of Tacoma, Department of Public Utilities, Power Division (d.b.a. "Tacoma Power"), owns approximately 13.06 acres of property located off of Howe Road in Lewis County ("Property"), with an estimated market value of \$160,515, as more fully described in the documents on file in the office of the City Clerk, and

WHEREAS the Property was acquired by Tacoma Power in 2011 as part of a larger, 73-acre purchase of property from Mr. David Filla, and

WHEREAS funds from the original acquisition were provided by the Cowlitz Fish Habitat Fund, established in accordance with Federal Energy Regulatory Commission License No. 2016 (Cowlitz River Hydroelectric Project), as part of Tacoma Power's efforts to enhance the Lower Cowlitz River fish habitat, and

WHEREAS, at the time of purchase, Mr. Filla was unable to exclude the subject 13.06 acres of Property from the sale, but has since completed a boundary line survey and offered to purchase said Property for the amount of \$160,515, and

WHEREAS Tacoma Water has determined that the Property is not necessary for current or future needs, and a negotiated sale in the amount of \$160,515 would be in the best interests of the City, and



WHEREAS, on May 14, 2014, by adoption of Public Utility Board
Resolution No. U-10692, the Property was declared surplus to the needs of
Tacoma Power and approved for sale, pending confirmation from the City
Council, and

WHEREAS, as required by state law, a public hearing was held on June 3, 2014, to allow the public to comment on the proposed sale, and no objections were received, and

WHEREAS, there being no foreseeable need for continued City ownership of the Property, a declaration of surplus and negotiated disposition of the Property and the execution of a Purchase and Sale Agreement to convey said Property in fee simple to Mr. Filla for the negotiated price of \$160,515 appears to be in the best interests of the City, pending final approval from the City Council; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

Section 1. That continued fee ownership of the City property, consisting of approximately 13.06 acres of City-owned real property located off of Howe Road in Lewis County, Washington, is not essential to the needs of the City and is hereby declared surplus property pursuant to RCW 35.22.020 and Article I, Section 1.2, and Article IX of the Tacoma City Charter.

Section 2. That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to enter into a Real Estate Purchase and Sale Agreement to convey this portion of real property in fee simple to Mr. David Filla for the negotiated price of \$160,515,
