## Presentation: Disability Rights Washington – David Lord, Director of Public Policy

- Disability Rights Washington (DRW) is a private non-profit organization that protects the rights of people with disabilities statewide.
- ➤ DRW is the entity designated by the Governor to provide protection and advocacy services to people with disabilities in Washington State.
- DRW's mission is to advance the dignity, equality, and self-determination of people with disabilities. They work to pursue justice on matters related to human and legal rights.
- Priorities are approved every year by the DRW Board of Directors. DRW seeks public input to help us set the priorities.
- Some of the ways in which DRW does policy work is by getting people together and discussing policy implications before legislative sessions. Another way is to cultivate connections with media.
- Some of the ways in which DRW can help municipalities are in areas of voting and advisory councils.
