

MOTION FOR CITY COUNCIL CONSIDERATION

APRIL 12, 2022

I move to amend Ordinance No. 28811 on Page 1, Line 22, to replace the number “90” with “30,” to read as follows:

WHEREAS any person who operates a motor vehicle in or during an unlawful exhibition of speed is guilty of a misdemeanor, which is punishable by up to 9930 days in jail, up to a \$1,000 fine, or by both such imprisonment and fine, and

I further move to amend Exhibit “A” of Ordinance No. 28811 on Page 4, Line 16, to replace the number “90” with “30,” to read as follows:

A. Any person (1) who has actual or constructive knowledge that he or she is in attendance of an unlawful exhibition of speed; and (2) who has actual or constructive knowledge that an unlawful exhibition of speed is occurring, has occurred, or is about to occur; and (3) was there with the intent to observe or support or encourage the unlawful exhibition of speed, is guilty of a misdemeanor, which is punishable by up to 930 days in jail, up to a \$1,000 fine, or by both such imprisonment and fine.
