

Letter of Agreement

**Subject: Collection Systems Technician accretion
October 2014**

The City of Tacoma and Professional and Technical Employees (PTE), Local 17 hereby enter into this Letter of Agreement which shall be attached to the collective bargaining agreement and incorporated as though fully set forth.

The classification of Collection Systems Technician (50080) became represented by PTE, Local 17 for purposes of collective bargaining through a Letter of Agreement dated 12/11/2013. It is hereby agreed that this classification is recognized as incorporated into and covered by the terms and conditions of the PTE, Local 17 collective bargaining agreement.

Further, the parties agree to the following:

- 2015 wages for this classification will be addressed through successor contract bargaining.
- Upon implementation of the successor agreement, the pay scale will be condensed to 5 steps, with 5% step increments.
- Effective with this LOA, employee(s) in the Collection Systems Technician classification will be eligible for longevity and all other terms and conditions for which the classification of Collection Systems Worker is eligible.
- This classification will be listed in Appendix A of the successor agreement.

This LOA and the elements contained herein are not considered precedent setting. The LOA will expire upon ratification and executive of the successor Professional and Technical Employees, Local 17 successor agreement.
