DATE: December 7, 2022

I ask for your support for a Contingency Fund expenditure of \$20,000 to support the Tacoma Community House in assisting Ukrainian refugees with direct client specific assistance for essential needs and programs.

LEGISLATIVE INTENT:

Council Contingency Fund Request:

Over the past 12 months, Tacoma Community (TCH) has experienced a dramatic influx of Ukrainian refugees, due to the unprovoked invasion of their country. More than 230 individuals, not counting 400+ family members, are enrolled in English classes, seeking employment and immigration services. Many have found shelter through the generosity of the Slavic communities in Pierce County, and monetary assistance through TCH's Ukrainian Fund.

Typically, resettlement relief flows from the Federal and State Government through to the county. However, access to those funds has not been secured due to the path refugees are taking to enter Pierce County. Due to TCH's historic connections to Ukrainian immigrant and refugee communities, they have taken a lead on welcoming Ukrainian refugees to Tacoma and Pierce County while Pierce County coordinates a long-term strategy to access funding and address the needs of this refugee community.

TCH has also developed and implemented a Language Access Plan, hired four additional ELA teachers and has filled all of its classes. In addition, TCH has hired a Ukrainian Resource Navigator, who assist clients by reducing communication barriers, providing integration resources and outreach to the existing Ukrainian community in Pierce County, an Immigration Case Worker to support immigration and work eligibility status and a Jobs Developer, also Ukrainian, to work across all TCH departments in assisting clients find meaningful work and connecting with area employers to host job fairs and employment workshop. Additional resources will support specific client assistance All three case workers are originally from Ukraine and are multi-lingual.

To further assist Ukrainian refugees, this contingency fund request is to support TCH to provide and support direct client specific assistance for essential needs and programs.

DESIRED RESOLUTION DATE: December 20, 2022

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT/ (CUSTOMER RESEARCH):

Ukraine is a diverse country with many ethnic backgrounds and there are thousands of Ukrainian born immigrants living in Tacoma and its suburbs. As of Nov 16, 2022, the Washington State Office of Refugee and Immigrant Assistance reports 1,284 Form-134 Applications Submitted by Uniting for Ukraine supporters in Pierce County. Ukrainian born Tacomans have asked the City of Tacoma to provide assistance in meeting the basic needs of Ukrainian refugees displaced by the unprovoked invasion of their country. Constituents have shared stories of Tacomans welcoming entire Ukrainian families into their homes, stretching their personal resources to care for refugees. There is a clear need to support these efforts and demonstrate how the City of Tacoma is a welcoming City.

2025 STRATEGIC PRIORITIES:

Equity and Accessibility:

Refugees fleeing war face many hardships while resettling in a new community. These individuals may arrive in the United States with little no resources and be dependent on government assistance. The Washington State Office of Refugee and Immigrant Assistance reports² a significant increase in Ukrainian clients on select Cash, Food, and Apple Health Medical Programs throughout the year. The burden of caring for these refugees is shared with the local families who host the refugees. Ukrainians participating in Uniting for Ukraine must have a supporter in the United States who agrees to provide them with financial support for the duration of their stay in the United States. This puts existing immigrant populations in a difficult situation as they stretch their resources further to care for a new wave of refugees.

Improve health outcomes and reduce disparities, in alignment with the community health needs assessment and CHIP, for all Tacoma residents

This funding will help fund access to basic necessities for Ukrainian refugees and their host families.

SPONSOR RECOMMENDATION:

Sponsors recommend the City Council demonstrate their commitment to being a welcoming City by providing \$20,000 to provide and support direct client specific assistance for essential needs and programs.

FISCAL IMPACT:

\$20,000 in contingency funds.
