Briefing Items

1. 24-0412 Multi-Family Call-2-Haul

[Lewis Griffith, P.E., Division Manager, Solid Waste Management]

At approximately 4:35p.m., Lewis Griffith, Solid Waste Division Manager, Environmental Services, presented the multi-family Call-2 Haul briefing including an overview; background, noting residential and commercial customer base and Call-2-Haul; utilization in residential versus commercial and single- versus multi-family homes; issues, noting informal survey of multi-family residents and property managers; proposed pilot; outreach, noting proposing a two-pronged approach; and next steps.

Discussion ensued regarding staffing for education and outreach; other services being used by property managers; curbside pickup; the need to conduct another public survey; education and outreach incorporated with the City's litter plan; target percentage for utilization of Call-2-Haul program; the cost savings of using Call-2-Haul verses taking the same amount of solid waste to the transfer station; commercial utilization; and efficiency of Call-2-Haul verses bulky item drop-off events.
