That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to extend the contract with Simon and Company for expert services to adequately represent the interests of the City before the United States Congress, the administration, and other federal agencies, with said contract amendment to be in the amount of \$130,000, plus \$14,000 for routine expenses, with moneys to be budgeted from the Public Works Surface Water Fund, for the period of January 1, 2007,



through December 31, 2008, said amendment to agreement to be substantially in the form of the document on file in the office of the City Clerk.
