2 3 4	AN ORDINANCE relating to wastewater; amending Subchapter 12.08C of the Municipal Code, relating to the Industrial Wastewater Pretreatment Program, by adding a new Section 12.08C.1320, entitled "Grease Interceptor Education Requirement", to establish requirements to educate commercial tenants and property owners on the conditions of		
5	⁵ private grease interceptors for food- or beverage-related businesses.		
6 7	WHEREAS commercial tenants or property owners intending to open		
8	food- or beverage-related businesses often sign a lease or purchase a property		
9	prior to contacting the Tacoma-Pierce County Health Department ("Health		
10	Department"), and/or the City's Planning and Development Services Permit		
11	Department ("Permit Department"), and		
12	WHEREAS current pretreatment regulations are required by the City's		
13 14	National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit to protect the		
15	City's wastewater treatment system from adverse impacts from fats, oils and		
16	grease, and		
17	WHEREAS the pretreatment regulations may require food- or beverage-		
18	related business to install new or upgraded grease interceptor equipment that		
19	exceeds the expectation of the business owner which may cause a significant delay		
20 21	in opening the business, a need to adjust the business plan, or may make the		
22	project infeasible, either financially or structurally, and

1 WHEREAS this ordinance would apply to all purveyors of commercial real 2 estate that is or will be occupied by any food- or beverage-related business, 3 including, but not limited to: sellers, brokers, agents, and property managers, and 4 WHEREAS this ordinance would create a requirement to disclose and 5 share information via an educational flyer created by the City about the potential 6 7 requirements to install or upgrade a grease interceptor system that meets current 8 environmental requirements as approved by the Permit Department, and the 9 disclosure and information would be provided to the potential lessee or buyers 10 prior to signing of a lease or completing a purchase of the property, and 11 WHEREAS the City's Environmental Services Department will create the 12 13 educational flyer and update as needed, and, in addition, the Permit Department 14 will provide the educational flyer anytime a food- or beverage-related business 15 engages with the permit process, and 16 WHEREAS the City will encourage the Health Department to provide the 17 flyer anytime they engage with food- or beverage-related businesses, and 18 19 WHEREAS this policy aims to provide critical education to new and 20 aspiring business owners so they can make wise future investments, and by 21 directing businesses to educational information and resources to learn about 22 infrastructure requirements before they commit to a lease or purchase, which will 23 help to even the playing field between experienced and new entrepreneurs, and 24 25 WHEREAS this policy, which is directly responsive to community concerns, 26 is one step to help food and beverage businesses succeed in the City so our entire

2	businesses that engaging with their City Council makes a positive impact on the

4 5	WHEREAS ensuring business owners know more about how to invest in	
6	the right grease inceptor for their business will help protect the wastewater	
7	treatment system and the natural environment from sanitary sewer backups	
8	caused by fats, oils, and grease; Now, Therefore,	
9	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TACOMA:	
10	Section 1. That the City Council hereby adopts the Recitals of this

13	Section 2. That Subchapter 12.08C of the Municipal Code, relating to the	
14	Industrial Wastewater Pretreatment Program, by adding a new

10	establish requirements to educate commercial tenants and property owners on the	
18	conditions of private grease interceptors for food- or beverage-related businesses, is	
19	hereby amended as set forth in the attached Exhibit "A."

8	Any person or entity transacting commercial real estate within the City of Tacoma, including but not limited to sellers, brokers, agents, landlords or property managers, shall provide to any customer,
0	potential buyer or tenant that intends to use the commercial real estate for a food- or beverage-related
9	business, with the then current Grease Interceptor Educational Flyer developed by the City prior to entering into or executing any lease, property sale or other formal written document conveying the
10	commercial real estate. This educational requirement is intended to assist food- and beverage-related
11	businesses learn about the requirements for installing or upgrading grease interceptors to prevent fats, oils and grease from the business entering into the POTW.
