4. <u>15-0958</u> Jail Services for Incarceration of City of Tacoma Misdemeanants [Mark Lauzier, City Manager's Office]

At approximately 4:32 p.m., Mark Lauzier, Assistant City Manager presented a draft agreement for inmate housing between Yakima County and the City of Tacoma. He discussed the current service agreements, issues, and recommended entering into the additional agreement with Yakima County in order to address jail bed capacity that will be lost once the South Correctional Entity (SCORE) emergency agreement expires at the end of the current calendar year. Discussion ensued regarding daily rates, and costs to the City.

MOTION: Council Member Campbell moved to forward the proposed agreement to the full City Council for consideration.
