**SUBJECT:** Ad Valorem Tax Levy and Emergency Medical Services Tax Levy – November 1, 2016

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**SUMMARY:**

The City of Tacoma is required by state law to annually approve the regular levy on property taxes for the following year. This resolution sets November 1, 2016 as the date for a public hearing on the proposed Ad Valorem tax levy and Emergency Medical Services (EMS) tax levy for 2017.

**BACKGROUND:**

RCW 84.55.120 requires that taxing districts, other than the state, that collects regular levies shall hold a public hearing on revenue sources for the district's following year's current expenses budget, and the hearing must include consideration of possible increases in property tax revenues and shall be held prior to the time the taxing district levies the taxes or makes the request to have the taxes levied.

**ISSUE:**

This resolution will set November 1, 2016 as the date for a public hearing on the proposed Ad Valorem tax levy and EMS tax levy for 2017.

**ALTERNATIVES:**

RCW 84.55.120 requires that the City of Tacoma hold a public hearing on the Ad Valorem tax levy and EMS property tax levy for the subsequent year; therefore, staff has not identified an alternative.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends that the City of Tacoma set November 1, 2016 as the date for a public hearing on the Ad Valorem tax levy and EMS tax levy for the subsequent year.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

There is no fiscal impact.
