Subject: Fiscal Impact of Local 31 Tacoma Firefighters Union Wage Increase for 2014

Background

Effective January 1, 2014 wage rates will be increased by 3.51% for Local 31 Tacoma Firefighters Union members.

Fiscal Impact Assumption for 2014

The estimated expense provided below includes the incremental cost by fund for the wage rate increase and includes the cost of benefits tied to salary. Benefits that are a fixed dollar amount will not change due to salary increases but are included in the estimated expense.

Funding

The total estimated cost in 2014 for salaries and wages for Local 31 Tacoma Firefighters Union including the 3.51% increase is \$47,178,156 (\$36,495,198 General Fund, \$10,682,958 million other general government funds) of which \$46,761,360 is included in the 2013-2014 budget.
