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
### **\*\*\***BACKGROUND

#### What is the Right-of-Way Design Manual?

 Minimum technical standards to construct improvements in the City's right-of-way (ROW)

#### Why do we have the Right-of-Way Design Manual?

- Required per RCW 35.78.040
- · Staff and project design guidance
- APWA Accreditation

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# PROPOSED REVISIONS City Policies and Objectives



Home in Tacoma

#### **Vision Zero**

- · Design Speed, Design Vehicle, Sight Distance
- Acknowledged other design guidance from NACTO & WSDOT Active Transportation Programs Design Guide
- · Additional consideration for all road users



#### **Home in Tacoma**

- · Additional flexibility for private access
- On-site pedestrian needs guidance related to land uses/Title 13 changes
- · Allowances for smaller designs in certain scenarios
- · Updated within ROW parking standards, including for bikes

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## PROPOSED REVISIONS Best Practices and Standards



#### **Transportation Master Plan**

- · Strengthens reference to TMP for design guidance
- · Added typical roadway cross-sections associated with roadway classifications

#### **Complete Streets**

- · Allocations of uses within the ROW
- · Streetside environments & provisions for pedestrians
- · Information now included concerning curb extensions/bulbouts
- · Traffic calming "toolbox" update

#### **Additional Policies/Objectives**

- · Chapter 9 Tree and Vegetation Management
- Chapter 11 Stormwater and Wastewater Sewer Design



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## PROPOSED REVISIONS Best Practices and Standards



#### Chapter 4 - Street Design

- Street Geometry
  - General restructuring and expansion/clarifications on various topics

#### **Pavement Design**

- New section (previously part of Street Section)
- Particular topics updated (or new):
  - Simplified Pavement Design
  - AASHTO Pavement Design
  - Pavement Restoration
  - Permeable Pavements
  - Subgrade

#### **Chapter 11 – Stormwater and Wastewater Sewer Design**

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## PROPOSED REVISIONS Miscellaneous



- Chapter 2 Right-of-Way/Site Permitting and Local Improvement Districts
- Chapter 3 Site Development Permit & Right-of-way Construction Plan Format
- Chapter 9 Tree and Vegetation Management
- Chapter 11 Stormwater and Wastewater Sewer Design
- Chapter 12 Water Plans

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### PROPOSED REVISIONS





#### Chapter 4 - Street Design

- Replacing previous "Street Typologies" approach with defining roadway classifications and providing typical configurations
- Focuses on the main design/technical resources for street design and references other City plans and policies that could affect rather than overwhelming with various cross-references
- Overall design guidance expectations established in Ch 4 Basis for Geometric Design
- Now includes a description of Permanent vs Temporary Improvements
- Expanded discussion and guidance on expectations for design of retaining walls

- Throughout process: Progress updates to the City's Standards Committee
- February 2024: Transportation Commission
- June 18, 2024: Summary presentation of updates/effort to Tacoma Permit Advisory Group (TPAG)
- October 16, 2024: Update to TPAG
- · Today: IPS
- End of October through end of 2024/January 2025:
  - Update to Transportation Commission
  - Notice of proposed changes conveyed to the development community via permit system

- Late October into January 2025: Continued outreach
- November 2024 into January 2025: Review/final edits
- Q1 2025: Municipal Code updates specific to new content elements (as needed)
- Q1 2025: Finalization and adoption by Public Works Director
