

RESOLUTION NO. 41656

BY REQUEST OF MAYOR WOODARDS

A RESOLUTION relating to student learning opportunities; authorizing the execution of an amendment to the Option Agreement with the Harold E. LeMay Museum to establish a 120-day notice period for exercise of the Option and supporting the Museum's request for state funding to develop a state-of-the-art robotics lab in partnership with the Tacoma School District No. 10.

WHEREAS in 2002, the City Council approved an Option and Development

Agreement ("Agreement") for the Harold E. LeMay Museum ("Museum") to be

developed on property adjacent to the Tacoma Dome, and

WHEREAS under the Agreement, the Museum was required to close on the first phase of property within five years, develop and open the Museum, and meet other criteria, all of which have been satisfied, and

WHEREAS the remaining future phase property remains under option to the Museum through 2029, and the notice period to the City for exercise of a second phase option is two (2) years advance notice, and

WHEREAS the two years' notice period was set to ensure that the Museum facility was constructed, and all other first phase requirements would be met before the Museum could exercise the second phase option, and

WHEREAS the Museum is in operation, all other first phase requirements are met, and the Museum is now prepared to exercise its second phase option, and

WHEREAS the Museum plans to partner with Tacoma School District No. 10 ("District") to develop a state-of-the-art robotics lab, with robotics classes to be held

on site, on the second phase site, which would continue, enhance, and expand the Museum's collaboration with the District, and

WHEREAS the second phase is directly adjacent to the Museum's show field and would allow outdoor and aerial robotics experiences, and would also directly connect to East, South, and Central Tacoma for convenient access for students from these communities, making the City a regional hub for primary and secondary robotics education, and

WHEREAS the District has funds available for its portion of the project and the Museum will seek the balance of funds necessary for the project from the state legislature this year, and

WHEREAS an amendment of the Museum's Agreement to reduce the notice period for exercise of the option to 120-days will support the Museum's request for state funding and meet the School District's timing needs for development of the state-of-the-art robotics lab; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

Section 1. That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to execute an amendment to the Option Agreement with the Harold E. LeMay Museum to reduce the notice period to 120-days for exercise of the second phase option to facilitate the development of a state-of-the-art robotics lab in partnership with the Tacoma School District No. 10, substantially as set forth in the Fourth Amendment to Option Agreement ("Amendment") on file in the office of the City Clerk.
