SUMMARY:

Appointing and re-appointing the following individuals to the Landmarks Preservation Commission: Jonah Jensen to the “Architect” designation to serve a three-year term beginning January 1, 2014 to expire December 31, 2016; Lysa Schloesser to the “Architect” designation to fill an unexpired term expiring December 31, 2014; Christopher Granfield to the “At-large” designation to fill an unexpired term expiring December 31, 2015; Duke York to the “Professional” designation to serve a three-year term beginning January 1, 2014 to expire December 31, 2016; and Jeff Williams to the “Professional” designation to serve a three-year term beginning January 1, 2014 to expire December 31, 2016.

COUNCIL SPONSORS:

BACKGROUND:

At the November 18, 2013 Neighborhoods and Housing Committee meeting, the Committee interviewed applicants and recommended the appointment and re-appointment of the individuals listed above.

ISSUE:

The Landmarks Preservation Commission currently has two unexpired terms; three terms expiring on December 31, 2013; and there will be one unexpired term on January 1, 2014 as a member will resign effective December 31, 2013.

ALTERNATIVES:

The Commission could still meet; however, they would not have full membership.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Neighborhoods and Housing Committee is recommending the appointment and re-appointment of the individuals listed above.
