- Complete Tideflats Subarea Plan work with stakeholders and partner governments to create and adopt a shared vision
- Adopt the Comp Plan Periodic Update work with the community and stakeholders to update the One Tacoma Plan
- Complete the update to the Historic Preservation Plan engage the community in better aligning historic preservation policies with housing and equity goals
- Complete South Tacoma Initiatives continue to work with the community to complete the South Tacoma Neighborhood Plan and Groundwater Protection code update
- Align fees adjust fees in accordance with the CPI-U (3.8%) and adopt fees for the new Urban Design Program
