

## **ORDINANCE NO. 28951**

AN ORDINANCE providing for the ratification and reconfirmation of Ordinance No. 28929, relating to the tax and license code; which amended Subtitle 6A of the Municipal Code, relating to the Tax Code, by amending Section 6A.30.065, entitled "Job credits", to narrow the definition of a green job and increase the value of the green job tax credit from \$250 to \$1,000 per year; and amended various sections throughout Chapter 6A.30, to update language, address areas of inconsistency, and comply with state law.

WHEREAS on December 19, 2023, the City Council duly enacted Ordinance No. 28929, and

WHEREAS the City Clerk provided a timely request to the City's official newspaper to publish a summary of said ordinance, and

WHEREAS on December 28, 2023, the City Clerk was notified by the City's official newspaper that as a result of a company-wide migration of its electronic mail, it failed to publish a summary of the ordinance, and

WHEREAS the City desires to correct the inadvertent procedural error in publication by ratifying and reconfirming the ordinance as adopted; Now, Therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TACOMA:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 28929 as adopted is hereby ratified and reconfirmed and shall be in full force and effect as if it had been published within ten days after passage.
