2. <u>16-0272</u> New Sister City Presentation [Carol Wolfe, Program Development Specialist, Community and Economic*Development]

At approximately 10:26 a.m., Carol Wolfe, Community and Economic Development, provided an overview of the process to add Boca del Rio, Mexico as Tacoma's 14th Sister City. Gonzalo Delgadillo, Broker One Sun Properties and Martha Cerna, Puget Sound Latino Chamber of Commerce, discussed the history of Veracruz, Mexico, tourist attractions, the Heroic Naval School, Port of Veracruz, culture, University of Veracruz, state map, state information, Boca del Rio and Veracruz Cities, and the spanish definitions, Mr. Delgadillo continued discussing the city of Boca del Rio, including Mayor Miguel Angel Yunes Marquez, strategic policy lines, city projects, hospitals, universities, libraries, a new port project, and the Nuevo Veracruz project.

Discussion ensued regarding the port and the relation to the City of Veracruz and Boca del Rio, robotics team, criteria needed for a Sister City, population of Boca del Rio, Veracruz port and comparison to City of Tacoma, work plan for Boca del Rio, investments, difference between a Sister City and twin city, and support toward Boca del Rio becoming the 14th Sister City.

MOTION: Council Member Thoms moved to recommend Boca del Rio, Mexico, as being named Tacoma's, 14th Sister City for consideration to the full City Council.
