



RESOLUTION NO. 40277

1 A RESOLUTION relating to surface water; authorizing the execution of a grant
2 agreement and any associated term extensions with the Washington State
3 Department of Ecology, and accepting the amount of \$1,589,000 for
4 deposit into the ES Surface Water Fund, for the purpose of installing
permeable pavement in the Manitou neighborhood, between South 64th
and South 66th Streets and Mullen and Mason Streets.

5 WHEREAS the Manitou Green Infrastructure Project (“Project”) will reduce
6 stormwater flow and improve stormwater quality in the Flett Creek Watershed
7 through the installation of permeable pavement in the Manitou District between
8 South 64th and South 66th Streets and Mullen and Mason Streets, and
9

10 WHEREAS the Project offers a unique opportunity to retrofit existing streets
11 into green infrastructure using permeable pavement, and

12 WHEREAS the proposed design has capacity to infiltrate over 2,500 linear
13 feet of road and sidewalk surface, plus the surrounding residential area, for a total
14 of eight acres, and

16 WHEREAS, in addition to reducing surface water runoff and associated load
17 of fine particulate matter, infiltrated water will improve base flow, which is
18 significant to the health of the creeks and wetlands in the area, and
19

20 WHEREAS the City has applied for and been awarded \$1,589,000 in grant
21 funding from the Washington State Department of Ecology for this Project, and

22 WHEREAS the grant award requires a City match of \$529,667 from the
23 ES Surface Water Fund, and

24 WHEREAS, under the grant process guidelines, the City Council must
25 approve acceptance of grant funding; Now, Therefore,

Section 1. That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to accept grant funding from the Washington State Department of Ecology in the amount of \$1,589,000, for deposit into the ES Surface Water Fund, for the purpose of installing permeable pavement in the Manitou neighborhood, between South 64th and South 66th Streets and Mullen and Mason Streets.

That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to execute a grant agreement and any associated term extensions with the Washington State Department of Ecology for the administration of the funding accepted pursuant to Section 1, said document to be substantially in the form of the proposed grant agreement on file in the office of the City Clerk.
