

## **RESOLUTION NO. 41567**

BY REQUEST OF COUNCIL MEMBERS DANIELS, SADALGE, AND SCOTT

A RESOLUTION authorizing the one-time use of funds in the amount of \$5,000, budgeted from the Council Contingency Fund, to support the annual Hilltop holiday event.

WHEREAS the Hilltop holiday event is a joyful, family-friendly and community focused event aimed at bringing people together to celebrate the Hilltop neighborhood and the season, and

WHEREAS families and friends are invited to create cherished memories while enjoying warm drinks from Red Elm, sweet treats from Love by the Slice, activities, and a performance by T.U.P.A.C. dancers, and

WHEREAS strings of lights in festive shapes, including a snowman and snowflakes, will be illuminated on the side of the T.U.P.A.C. building following a group countdown, and

WHEREAS, in addition, decorative wreaths will be installed on light posts along Martin Luther King Jr. Way in the Hilltop Business District to create a festive and inviting environment for local shops, and

WHEREAS this event is hosted by the Hilltop Action Coalition, a non-profit that aims to engage residents and business owners seeking to play an active role in restoring the Hilltop community; and the group also provides neighborhood news, opportunities for networking, and helps to host events that showcase the Hilltop and its community, and

WHEREAS, at the November 19, 2024 Study Session, Council

Member Jamika Scott shared a Council Consideration Request to authorize the



one-time use of \$5,000 from the Council Contingency Fund to sponsor the annual Hilltop holiday event, and

WHEREAS City staff will negotiate and execute an agreement for services, with terms and deliverables for the City's contribution, and

WHEREAS RCW 35.34.250 and 35.34.260 authorize a withdrawal from the Council Contingency fund for any municipal expense, the necessity or extent of which could not have been foreseen or reasonably evaluated at the time of adopting the budget, and

WHEREAS Ordinance No. 22569 requires an affirmative vote of not less than six members of the Council in order to withdraw moneys from this fund, and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that City participation in the Hilltop holiday event is a fundamental governmental purpose within the City's authority to provide for economic development and investment in the City of Tacoma which is sufficient consideration to the public to justify the City's investment; Now, Therefore.

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

Section 1. That the foregoing Recitals are hereby adopted as the City Council's legislative findings.

Section 2. That one-time funding in the amount of \$5,000, budgeted from the Council Contingency Fund, is hereby approved for the purpose of sponsoring the annual Hilltop holiday event.

Section 3. That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to
