RESOLUTION NO. TBD 022

A RESOLUTION relating to the City of Tacoma Transportation District; setting Tuesday, October 29, 2024, at approximately 5:30 p.m., as the date for a public hearing on the proposed 2025-2026 Transportation Benefit District Budget and Spending Plan.

WHEREAS RCW 35.21.225 and 36.73.020 and City Ordinance No. 28099 authorized the establishment of a Transportation Benefit District ("TBD") for the purposes of acquiring, constructing, improving, providing, and funding transportation improvements within the TBD consistent with any state, regional, or local transportation plans, and necessitated by existing or reasonably foreseeable congestion levels, and

WHEREAS, on November 27, 2012, the TBD Governing Board ("Board") adopted Resolution No. TBD 001, authorizing the collection of a vehicle license fee of \$20, and

WHEREAS on July 14, 2015, the Board adopted Amended Resolution No. TBD 008 to place ballot measure Proposition No. 4, later referred to as Proposition A, on the ballot for the General Election, authorizing a sales tax increase of one tenth of one percent (0.1 percent) to fund street improvements, which passed in the November 3, 2015, General Election, and

WHEREAS the City's Office of Management and Budget estimates that the City will collect \$5,796,000 in authorized vehicle license fees, and \$9,493,127 from the sales tax increase of one tenth of one percent, which is a decrease in revenues of \$5,668,429 from the previous biennium, as the revenue



generated from the sales tax increase of one tenth of one percent sunsets on December 31, 2025, and

WHEREAS the total proposed TBD Budget/Spending Plan for the 2025-2026 biennium is \$15,705,299, comprised of estimated TBD revenues of \$15,289,127, \$51,772 of invested revenues, and \$364,400 of cash on hand, and

WHEREAS RCW 36.73.020 states that the Board shall consider the following criteria when selecting transportation improvements: (1) reduced risk of transportation facility failure and improved safety; (2) improved travel time; (3) improved air quality; (4) increases in daily and peak period trip capacity;

(5) improved modal connectivity; (6) improved freight mobility; (7) costeffectiveness of the investment; (8) optimal performance of the system through time; and (9) other criteria, as adopted by the governing body in Tacoma Municipal Code 10.28, and

WHEREAS a Budget/Spending Plan is necessary to outline the transportation improvements to be funded by the TBD, appropriate funds for said improvements, and coordinate with stakeholders and utilities; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE TACOMA
TRANSPORTATION BENEFIT DISTRICT:

Section 1. That a public hearing on the 2025-2026 Transportation Benefit
District Budget/Spending Plan shall be held before the Governing Board of the
Tacoma Transportation Benefit District in the Council Chambers on the first floor of
the Tacoma Municipal Building, 747 Market Street, Tacoma, Washington, and may



be offered in a hybrid format that includes a remote option, on Tuesday, October 29, 2024, at approximately 5:30 p.m. or as soon thereafter as the same may be heard. Section 2. That the Clerk of the City of Tacoma shall give proper notice of the time and place of said hearings. Adopted _____ Victoria R.
