SUMMARY AND PURPOSE:

A resolution authorizing the one-time use of Council Contingency Funds, in the amount of \$1,000, to sponsor the Juneteenth Prayer Breakfast.

BACKGROUND:

This event serves as the civic cornerstone of Juneteenth: A Road to Economic Freedom, setting the tone for Washington State's largest Juneteenth celebration. Held on the morning of June 19 at the LeMay Car Museum, the Breakfast brings together community leaders, residents, businesses, and organizations to reflect on the significance of Juneteenth and recommit to the values of justice, unity, opportunity, and shared prosperity. Through remarks, recognition of community leadership, and fellowship, the event honors the legacy of emancipation while highlighting the ongoing work required to advance equity and economic opportunity for all.

This year's themes of freedom, economic justice, accountability, and hope, underscore the importance of creating pathways to economic mobility and strengthening partnerships that support thriving communities. These themes carry forward throughout the broader Juneteenth celebration, which welcomes more than 20,000 attendees, features nationally recognized performing artists, and showcases hundreds of small businesses, entrepreneurs, nonprofits, and community partners.

Sponsorship of this event supports critical event logistics and programming while demonstrating the City's commitment to recognizing Juneteenth as both a celebration of freedom and a call to action. By supporting the Breakfast, the City helps foster meaningful community dialogue, elevate the contributions of Black residents and businesses, and set the stage for a day dedicated to unity, economic empowerment, and community connection.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT/ CUSTOMER RESEARCH:

The Juneteenth Breakfast is organized through extensive collaboration between community leaders, nonprofit organizations, businesses, and public sector partners. The event serves as a gathering space for residents, stakeholders, and elected officials to reflect on the significance of Juneteenth and engage in dialogue about economic opportunity, equity, and community well-being. As the opening event of the region's largest Juneteenth celebration, the Breakfast helps strengthen relationships across sectors and fosters meaningful community connection and participation. The city of Tacoma leans on our community leaders who have done the engagement, outreach, and collaboration to design a leading Juneteenth event in Washington.

2025 STRATEGIC PRIORITIES:

Equity and Accessibility:

The Juneteenth Breakfast advances the City's commitment to equity by recognizing the history, contributions, and ongoing experiences of Black communities while creating space for dialogue, celebration, and economic



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empowerment. The event is designed to be accessible to a broad cross-section of the community and supports inclusive participation by bringing together residents, community organizations, businesses, and civic leaders to foster understanding, opportunity, and belonging.
