



RESOLUTION NO. 41494

1 A RESOLUTION related to the purchase of materials, supplies or equipment, and
2 the furnishing of services; authorizing the execution of a contract with
3 General Mechanical, Inc., in the amount of \$1,399,571.00, plus applicable
4 taxes, plus a four percent contingency, budgeted from the Transportation
5 Capital & Engineering Fund, for the installation of one vertical asphalt oil
6 storage tank with all associated pumps, piping, insulation, heat trace,
7 ladders, catwalk, and including a concrete foundation and secondary
8 containment, for a projected contract total of \$1,455,553.84, pursuant to
9 Specification No. PW24-0070F.

10 WHEREAS the City has complied with all applicable laws and processes
11 governing the acquisition of those supplies, and/or the procurement of those
12 services, inclusive of public works, as is shown by the attached Exhibit "A,"
13 incorporated herein as though fully set forth, and

14 WHEREAS the Board of Contracts and Awards has concurred with the
15 recommendation for award as set forth in the attached Exhibit "A"; Now, Therefore,

16 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

17 Section 1. That the Council of the City of Tacoma concurs with the Board of
18 Contracts and Awards to adopt the recommendation for award as set forth in the
19 attached Exhibit "A."



Section 2. That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with General Mechanical, Inc., in the amount of \$1,399,571.00, plus applicable taxes, plus a four percent contingency, budgeted from the Transportation Capital & Engineering Fund, for the installation of one vertical asphalt oil storage tank with all associated pumps, piping, insulation, heat trace, ladders, catwalk, and including a concrete foundation and secondary containment, for a projected contract total of \$1,455,553.84, pursuant to Specification No. PW24-0070F, consistent with Exhibit "A."
