

## RESOLUTION NO. 38725

A RESOLUTION relating to port security; authorizing the execution of an Interlocal Agreement with the Port of Tacoma for services provided by the Tacoma Fire Department relating to coordination and management of the Port of Tacoma Emergency Warning System; and authorizing the acceptance of \$210,000 from the Port of Tacoma, for deposit into the Miscellaneous Special Revenue Fund, for services related to said project.

WHEREAS, as part of ongoing emergency management planning, the City and Port of Tacoma ("Port") desire to enhance the ability to warn citizens of certain potential Port-area emergency events through the installation and support of a Port of Tacoma Emergency Warning System ("Project"), and

WHEREAS the proposed interlocal agreement designates the Tacoma Fire

Department ("TFD") as project manager for the Project and assigns tasks and

provides Project milestones for related work performed by the TFD, and

WHEREAS all Project work is required to be completed no later than January 31, 2014, and

WHEREAS the Port will pay the City \$210,000 of federal Port Security grant funding as compensation for Project-related work performed by the TFD over a five-month period; Now, Therefore,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

Section 1. That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with the Port of Tacoma for services performed by the Tacoma Fire Department relating to coordination and management of the Port of Tacoma Emergency Warning System, said agreement to be substantially in the form of the proposed document on file in the office of the City Clerk.



Section 2. That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to accept the sum of \$210,000 from the Port of Tacoma, for deposit into the Miscellaneous Special Revenue Fund, for services related to said project. Adopted \_\_\_\_\_ Mayor Attest: City Clerk Approved as to form:
