- Appointing Erica Chang to the “At-Large No. 8” position to serve a three-year term, effective January 1, 2025, to expire December 31, 2027.
- Appointing Ean Olsen to the “Working Professional Artist” position to serve a three-year term, effective January 1, 2025, to expire December 31, 2027.
- Reappointing Heide Fernandez-Llamazares to the “Professional Position 3” position to serve a three-year term, effective January 1, 2025, to expire December 31, 2027.
