and Level 3 Communications, LLC (a subsidiary of Lumen)

DATE: August 26, 2025

SUMMARY AND PURPOSE:

The purpose of this item is to Request an Ordinance for a 10-year Telecommunications Franchise Agreement between the City of Tacoma and Level 3 Communications, LLC (a subsidiary of Lumen). This is the third such ordinance for Level 3 (Ord. No. 26465 – 1999, Ord. No. 28214 – 2014). We have reviewed their request, negotiated terms, and reached a tentative agreement pending City Council consideration and approval. Based on Level 3's (a subsidiary of Lumen) Financial and Technical abilities, and History as a provider.

BACKGROUND:

This department's recommendation is based on State and Local Law which requires a Telecommunications Provider to have a Franchise Agreement to operate in the City of Tacoma Public Right of Way.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT/ CUSTOMER RESEARCH:

Businesses in our community will be impacted by this decision as Level 3 Communications has had a presence in our community for 25 years and will continue to offer competitive services at competitive rates.
