**SUMMARY:**

Appointing the following individuals to the Tacoma Community Redevelopment Authority Board to the “Attorney” designation; Mathew LaCroix to serve a two-year term to expire December 31, 2016; and Daniel Montopoli to fill an unexpired term to expire December 31, 2015.

**COUNCIL SPONSORS:**

**STRATEGIC POLICY PRIORITY:**

Appointing individuals to the Board best aligns with the strategic policy priority related to fostering neighborhood, community, and economic development vitality and sustainability because the Board administers loans to a variety of clients such as low-income families who need help in buying or repairing their homes, owners who provide multi-family housing to low-income families, businesses which create jobs or rehabilitate older, blighted buildings, and non-profit organizations that provide services to our community.

**BACKGROUND:**

At the November 3, 2014 Neighborhoods and Housing Committee meeting, the Committee interviewed applicants and recommended the appointment of the individuals listed above.

**ISSUE:**

There are currently two openings for the “Attorney” designation on the Tacoma Community Redevelopment Authority Board.
