

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South Tacoma Groundwater Protection District (STGPD)



- Created in 1988 as an overlay zone in Title 13 of the Tacoma Municipal Code.
- Encompasses the South Tacoma aquifer recharge area.
- Created to protect aquifer drinking water from contamination.
- Applies to businesses/commercial uses.
- Prohibits incompatible land uses.
- Establishes standards for hazardous substance storage, stormwater infiltration, spill prevention, and inspections.
- Lead agencies: Tacoma-Pierce County Health Department (TPCHD), Tacoma Water, Environmental Services, Planning and Development Services (PDS).




- Initiated moratorium review
- · Adopted STGPD Work Plan
- 2. Adoption: On March 7, 2023, the City Council passed Ordinance No. 28872, enacting a moratorium within the STGPD as recommended by the Infrastructure, Planning, and Sustainability (IPS) Committee.
 - Uses Temporarily Prohibited:
 - Underground Storage Tanks
 - · Metal recycling/auto wrecking
 - Existing Uses:
 - · Prohibit expansion of existing facilities
 - Allow normal maintenance, repair, replacement activities, and existing operations
 - Allow site and facility improvements to comply with building code, stormwater, and environmental standards

STGPD Landscaping/Tree Canopy


Background:


- Community input highlighted tree canopy deficit and associated health/heat island impacts
- December 2023 Planning Commission expanded STGPD scope to include landscaping and tree canopy review for the South Tacoma Manufacturing Industrial Center and Tacoma Mall Regional Growth Center
- Presented approach to City Council as part of prior moratorium extension
- August 2024 presenting benchmarking comparisons for regional jurisdictions and preliminary recommendations to Planning Commission, South Tacoma Neighborhood Council and Neighborhood Plan Steering Group

- Tree canopy

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
