- Inclusion does not guarantee funding or completion



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
BACKGROUND

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E 34TH ST DECK REPAIR & SEISMIC RETROFIT



Project Detail: This project includes seismic repairs to the bridge support, bridge deck, streetlighting, and pedestrian separation.

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PEDESTRIAN ACCESSIBILITY IMPROVEMENTS



Project Detail:
This project will construct curb ramps and short sections of missing link sidewalks to support accessibility for all users.

HUD Community Development Fund \$3,000,000; Streets Initiative \$100,000

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●●● J STREET BIKE BOULEVARD

Project Detail:
 This project will construct a two-mile bicycle boulevard on J St from N 3rd St to S 27th St. It includes traffic calming and through traffic restrictions.

Funding:
 Transportation Alternatives Program Grant \$2,500,000; Streets Initiative \$1,961,044; Community and Economic Development Contribution \$175,000

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●●● SHERIDAN AVE COMPLETE STREETS

Project Detail: This project includes up to 3 phases on Sheridan Avenue between 56th and 72nd Streets. Phase 1 is funded and includes roadway reconstruction and complete streets accommodations.

Funding: Streets Initiative \$2,394,332; Real Estate Excise Tax \$400,000; Transportation Improvement Board Grant \$3,560,000; Unidentified City \$1,865,000
