

HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

1961 - Justice Court Reorganization Act; 1962 — Court formed as a Municipal Department of the Pierce County Justice Court (now known as the Pierce County District Court);

TODAY - Tacoma Municipal Court has been a Municipal Department of the Pierce County District Court for over 60 years.

LEGAL BACKGROUND

RCW Chapter 3.46 - Municipal Departments; RCW Chapter 3.48 - District Court Districts; PCC Chapter 2.54 - District Court Districting Plan; RCW Chapter 3.34 - District Judges; RCW 3.34.150 and GR 29 - Presiding Judge.



RCW 3.46.020

"Each judge of a municipal department shall be a judge of the district court in which the municipal department is situated. Such judge shall be designated as a municipal court judge."

RCW 3.34.010 and PCC 2.54.020

Pierce County must have 11 District Court Judges, 3 of which are designated as Judges of the Tacoma Municipal Court.



RCW 3.46 and PCC 2.54

- Salaries of the Municipal Judges are allocated to Tacoma;
- Only Tacoma voters may vote for Municipal Judges;
- Municipal Court personnel are specifically designated as employees of Tacoma.

RCW 3.34.150 and GR 29

- 1 Presiding Judge;
- Sole Responsibility for supervision of court daily operation, all personnel performing court functions and all personnel employed under the judicial branch of government.



MAJOR ISSUES

- No administrative or supervisory structure;
- Tacoma Presiding Judge;
- Tacoma Court Rules;
- Tacoma Court Operations and Procedures.

IMPORTANT THRESHOLD FACTS

No Due Process Rights Were Violated.

The Municipal Court Remains And Always Has Been A Separate Branch Of Tacoma Government.



REMEDY = New PCDC Rules

- Municipal Judicial Committee;
- Delegation of authority to Municipal Committee Chair;
- Reporting and Conferring process;
- Supervisory process;
- Revocation of TMC GR 29;
- Adoption of remaining TMC rules.

PRACTICAL EFFECTS

No change to daily operations;

No change to therapeutic courts;

No change to daily supervisory authority, but with PCDC GR29 oversight;

Personnel remain employees of TMC;

All policies, regulations and contracts remain in effect;

All court personnel supervisory chains remain in effect.
