Background – Tideflats





- 5,000 acres of waterfront and industrial lands
- Ancestral lands of the Puyallup Tribe of Indians
- Port of Tacoma
- Designated Manufacturing and Industrial Center (MIC)
- Critical saltwater and freshwater habitats
- Located within dense urban context

Background – Shared Planning

- The Subarea Plan is a shared planning effort among five participating governments.
 - > Guided by adopted Work Plan and Inter-governmental Agreement
- Intended to fulfill state and regional planning requirements, including Growth Management Act, Shoreline Management Act, State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA), and VISION 2050 compliance.
 - ▶ Upon adoption, Subarea Plan becomes element of the One Tacoma Plan.













3. Delete the S-10 and S-9 Shoreline Districts; replace with base zoning from TMC 13
4. Update list of prohibited uses
5. Reorganization and formatting for usability
