

## **RESOLUTION NO. 38829**

A RESOLUTION relating to public safety; authorizing the execution of an interlocal agreement with the Washington State Patrol for the purpose of allowing reimbursement of fire mobilization costs incurred pursuant to activation of the Washington State Fire Services Resource Mobilization Plan.

WHEREAS the Washington State Fire Services Resource Mobilization

Plan ("Mobilization Plan") provides a statewide process to quickly notify,

assemble, and deploy fire service personnel and equipment to any jurisdiction in

Washington that has expended all local and mutual aid resources to manage and

mitigate an emergency incident, and

WHEREAS the Tacoma Fire Department ("TFD") has, on occasion, provided resources and equipment to assist the state and/or other jurisdictions in fighting fires and responding to other emergencies, and

WHEREAS such deployments occur rarely, usually when additional resources for structural firefighting are needed, and

WHEREAS, in the past two decades, TFD resources were deployed to two significant events; thus, TFD staff estimates that there is a 10 percent chance each year that a deployment could occur, with an estimated average annual cost risk of \$23,000, of which approximately 75 percent would be eligible for reimbursement; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

That the proper officers of the City of Tacoma are hereby authorized to enter into an interlocal agreement with the Washington State Patrol for the purpose of allowing for reimbursement of fire mobilization costs incurred pursuant
