Mr. Nelson called the Public Utility Board study session to order at 3:03 p.m. at the Public Utilities Administration Building.

Total Quality Annual Report

Crystal Vaarvik, Total Quality (TQ) Program Manager and TQ council members, Eric Fay, and Dave Rosholm presented the report. TPU encourages an open and collaborative environment that fosters continuous improvement for positive changes to benefit customers and employees. TQ is integrated into the culture to make a measurable difference. The TQ council and manager serve as continuous improvement resources to TPU. TQ's work with different work groups and across divisions was outlined. Change management helps project managers and business leaders look at change impacts on the organization in advance of the change. The change management component of TQ was highlighted. TQ's focus in 2014 is on individual council members' leadership and TQ outreach and leveraging cross-functional position to support TPU-wide initiatives.

Tacoma Power: Energy Risk Management Report

Cam LeHouillier, Energy Risk Manager, detailed the wholesale market conditions (precipitation and snow pack; temperature and natural gas fundamentals). Graphical representations of each were shared. The biennium wholesale revenues and regulatory developments were detailed.

Tacoma Power: Click! Rate Adjustment

Pam Burgess, Click! Business Operations Manager, outlined Click!'s rate setting process and the basis for the proposed 2014 rate adjustment. Graphs illustrating programming costs, financial impacts, and recommended rates were detailed. Market comparisons and cable bill comparisons were summarized. Next steps for implementation were presented.

Miscellaneous

Water Superintendent, Linda McCrea, updated the Board on water levels in the Green River.

Terry Coggins, Facilities Maintenance Manager, briefed the Board on walk-on resolution U-10683, authorizing the award for a new on-site food services contractor for TPU.
