



## RESOLUTION NO. 40651

1 A RESOLUTION relating to collective bargaining; authorizing the execution of a  
2 Letter of Agreement negotiated between the City of Tacoma and City of  
3 Tacoma Washington, City and Pierce County Employees Local Number 120  
4 of the Washington State Council of County and City Employees, AFSCME,  
5 AFL-CIO, regarding the pay range for the classification of Senior Buyer,  
6 effective January 1, 2020.

7 WHEREAS the City has, for years, adopted the policy of collective  
8 bargaining between the various labor organizations representing employees and  
9 the administration, and

10 WHEREAS Resolution No. 40623, adopted July 7, 2020, authorized the  
11 execution of the one-year Collective Bargaining Agreement (“CBA”) between the  
12 City of Tacoma and City of Tacoma Washington, City and Pierce County  
13 Employees Local Number 120 of the Washington State Council of County and City  
14 Employees, AFSCME, AFL-CIO (“Union”), on behalf of the employees represented  
15 by said Union, and

16 WHEREAS the City and Union have negotiated a Letter of Agreement  
17 (“LOA”) to the CBA which provides for a correction of an error in the calculation of  
18 the general wage increase for the Senior Buyer classification which was included in  
19 Ordinance No. 28680, passed on July 14, 2020, and the correction will be  
20 retroactive to January 1, 2020, and

21 WHEREAS the LOA was considered and approved by the Public Utility  
22 Board at its special meeting of August 26, 2020, and

23 WHEREAS it appears in the best interest of the City that the LOA negotiated  
24 by said Union and the City be approved; Now, Therefore,  
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BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

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That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to execute the Letter of Agreement negotiated between the City of Tacoma and City of Tacoma Washington, City and Pierce County Employees Local Number 120 of the Washington State Council of County and City Employees, AFSCME, AFL-CIO, said document to be substantially in the form of the document on file in the office of the City Clerk.
