

RESOLUTION NO. 41698

BY REQUEST OF DEPUTY MAYOR DANIELS AND COUNCIL MEMBERS BUSHNELL AND SCOTT

A RESOLUTION authorizing the one-time use of funds in the amount of \$15,000, budgeted from the Council Contingency Fund, to supplement the \$30,000 South Tacoma Neighborhood Planning Booster funding, to conduct a full Green Blocks-scale program in the South Tacoma neighborhood.

WHEREAS Green Blocks is a community outreach-driven tree planting initiative co-managed by Tacoma Tree Foundation and City of Tacoma Urban Forestry, which entails door-to-door outreach along priority planting corridors and working with individual property owners to select, deliver, and plant trees in the public right-of-way adjacent to their properties, at no charge, and

WHEREAS the program culminates in a volunteer community tree planting event where volunteers provide planting assistance, with previous Green Blocks programs resulting in hundreds of new trees planted in the Tacoma Mall, McKinley, Lincoln, and Hilltop neighborhoods, and

WHEREAS during the \$50,000 participatory budget process for the South Tacoma Neighborhood Planning Booster Grant, which received over 600 votes, the community voted to fund two projects, with tree planting support being the top project and receiving \$30,000, and

WHEREAS staff then reached out to Urban Forestry, Parks Tacoma, the Tacoma Tree Foundation, and the Trust for Public Land to collaborate on a project for South Tacoma, and

WHEREAS the \$15,000 of Council Contingency funding will supplement the \$30,000 South Tacoma Neighborhood Planning Booster funding, with the \$15,000



allowing the program to move forward at full scale, similar in scope and size to previous iterations of Green Blocks in other neighborhoods, and

WHEREAS while the booster grant and Council Contingency funding will primarily support the administrative needs for the program, the City's Urban Forestry Program will supplement with fee-in-lieu funds to support the program, including the purchase of trees, soil, mulch, stakes, watering bags, and other supporting materials, and

WHEREAS, at the June 3, 2025, Study Session, Council Member Bushnell shared a Council Consideration Request to authorize the one-time use of \$15,000 from the Council Contingency Fund to supplement the \$30,000 South Tacoma Neighborhood Planning Booster funding, to conduct a full Green Blocks-scale program in the South Tacoma neighborhood, and

WHEREAS City staff will negotiate and execute an agreement for services, with terms and deliverables for the City's contribution, and

WHEREAS RCW 35.34.250 and 35.34.260 authorize a withdrawal from the Council Contingency fund for any municipal expense, the necessity or extent of which could not have been foreseen or reasonably evaluated at the time of adopting the budget, and

WHEREAS Ordinance No. 22569 requires an affirmative vote of not less than six members of the Council in order to withdraw moneys from this fund; Now, Therefore,



BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

Section 1. That the foregoing Recitals are hereby adopted as the City Council's legislative findings.

Section 2. That one-time funding in the amount of \$15,000, budgeted from the Council Contingency Fund, is hereby approved for the purpose of supplementing the \$30,000 South Tacoma Neighborhood Planning Booster funding, to conduct a full Green Blocks-scale program in the South Tacoma neighborhood.

Section 3. That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to confirm deliverables with Green Blocks for the purposes hereinabove enumerated, and document as appropriate.
