SUMMARY AND PURPOSE:

A resolution setting the 2025 appointments of Council Members to various committees, boards, and commissions.

BACKGROUND:

In addition to incorporating feedback from the Council, Mayor Woodards strives to balance City Council committee, board, and commission assignments based on a number of criteria, including Council areas of interests and expertise, availability, and number of roles assigned.

Pursuant to the Tacoma City Charter and the rules, regulations, and procedures of the City Council, Mayor Woodards brings forward for your consideration a resolution that would confirm appointments for the 2025 calendar year. Appointments are active through 2025 and may serve into 2026 until the 2026 appointment resolution is adopted.
