#### 1. Call to Order; Roll Call

There were also some updates on capacity building opportunities with Collaborative Partners Initiative (CPIN), the JEDI Cohort with Colemon & Associates, and School's Out Washington (SOWA).

TCAB member Allison Campbell reported out on behalf of the Reauthorization Committee, and shared that the op-ed was published in the Tacoma News Tribune. TCAB members Faith Brown and Mandy Zylstra then shared updates from the ELO Committee meeting.

#### 7. Discussion Item

Chair Mattran introduced the discussion topic for the meeting, and shared why she suggested going over organizational eligibility. Staff presented information on organizational eligibility for Tacoma Creates funding, and the process of the Eligibility Committee. There was robust conversation and questions from TCAB members on organizational eligibility and process.
