Appointing Johnaye Kendrick to the At-Large No. 3 position to serve a one-year term to expire December 31, 2016; reappointing Donald Lacky to the At-Large No. 1 position to serve a two-year term to expire December 31, 2017; and reappointing Scott Campbell to the Working Professional Artist position, Rachel Cardwell to the Cross District Association/Community Council position, Traci Kelly to the Professional No. 3 position, and Michael Sweney to the Professional No. 4 position to serve three-year terms to expire December 31, 2018.
