

RESOLUTION NO. 39216

A RESOLUTION relating to public safety and human services; authorizing the execution of a five-year agreement with Pierce County to provide jail services for the City of Tacoma.

WHEREAS the City currently holds an agreement with Pierce County for booking and incarceration needs, which is set to expire on December 31, 2015, and

WHEREAS, in March 2015, the Pierce County Sheriff's Office suspended services to the City based upon staffing shortages, and

WHEREAS the City also received notice from the City of Fife on March 2, 2015, terminating the Jail Services Agreement Between the City of Fife and City of Tacoma effective May 30, 2015, and

WHEREAS, in late February, the City began working with Pierce County on a long-term agreement to supersede and replace the current agreement between the parties, as it became clear that an agreement for a long-term contract with the City of Fife was unlikely, and

WHEREAS the new proposed five-year jail services agreement with Pierce County provides that by October 1, 2015, the Pierce County Jail will be able to house up to 75 pre-sentence inmates daily, allowing the City to keep a substantial number of pre-sentence inmates in Pierce County, and

WHEREAS the proposed agreement provides that the City will make six monthly payments of \$98,996 to Pierce County in 2015, for a total of \$593,976, to hire new staff and provide for training and overtime wages during

the ramp-up period (second half of 2015), which will allow Pierce County to open a new pod to house City of Tacoma inmates, and

WHEREAS the proposed agreement provides that the City will pay Pierce County a rate of \$75.80 per inmate bed in 2015, representing a 21 percent decrease from the current daily rate of \$92 per inmate, and a rate of \$75.25 per inmate bed in 2016, which would yield a monthly payment of approximately \$171,665, based on 75 beds, and

WHEREAS booking fees will be \$50 per inmate and transport costs to the Tacoma Municipal Court will be \$120 per trip, regardless of the number of inmates transported on the trip, and

WHEREAS the proposed agreement with Pierce County, in conjunction with proposed agreements with the Nisqually Indian Tribe and the South Correctional Entity ("SCORE"), will address the immediate need to replace the jail and related services no longer being provided by the City of Fife, and

WHEREAS, at a special meeting held on June 10, 2015, the Public Safety, Human Services and Education Committee considered the proposed agreement with Pierce County, together with the proposed SCORE Jail Services Agreement and Nisqually Indian Tribe Jail Services Agreement, and recommended all three agreements for consideration by the City Council; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to execute a Jail Services Agreement with Pierce County to provide jail services for the City for a



	period of five years, said document to be substantially in the form of the
