Fiscal Impact of New Wastewater Operator in Training Classification for 2014

Overview

The following provides a financial analysis for wage increases for a new classification of Wastewater Operator in Training effective in 2014 (date is dependent on Council adoption). This classification will be used with two existing filled positions. The classification will be a percentage of the existing Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator classification, resulting in a \$2.58 per hour increase for the two incumbents.

Fiscal Impact Assumption for 2014

Effective with Council adoption, wage rates for a new classification of Wastewater Operator in Training have been negotiated to increase by \$2.58 per hour over the current wage of Wastewater Treatment Plant Assistant. The fiscal impact is calculated for the whole of 2014.

Funding for 2014

The total estimated cost in 2014 for salaries and benefits for the new Wastewater Operator in Training Classification, including the increase discussed above, is \$163,867 (\$0 General Fund, \$163,867 General Government Utilities, \$0 other general government funds, \$0 Tacoma Public Utilities). The total cost of the negotiated increase is included in the 2013-2014 biennial budget.
