**SUMMARY:**

Appointing Dana Coggon to the At-Large No. 1 position, Tara Newton to the Council District No. 2 position, and Krystle Edwards to the Council District No. 3 position to serve three-year terms to expire December 31, 2020, and Alex Strautman to the At-Large No. 3 position to fill an unexpired term to expire December 31, 2019; and reassigning Daniel Thomasson from the At-Large No. 3 position to the Council District No. 4 position to fill an unexpired term to expire December 31, 2019.
