

RESOLUTION NO. 38941

A RESOLUTION relating to historic preservation; adding the proposed landmark to the Tacoma Register of Historic Places and imposing controls for the following property: the Municipal Barn, located at 2324 South C Street; said landmark designated by the Landmarks Preservation Commission under Chapter 13.07 of the Tacoma Municipal Code.

WHEREAS the Tacoma Landmarks and Historic Districts Code,
Chapter 13.07 of the Tacoma Municipal Code ("TMC"), establishes a procedure
for the designation and preservation of structures and areas having historical,
cultural, architectural, archaeological, engineering, or geographic importance, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to TMC 13.07.050, the nomination of the Municipal

Barn, located at 2324 South C Street ("Property"), currently owned by the City of Tacoma and occupied by the Public Works Street Operations Division, was submitted by Historic Tacoma for inclusion on the Tacoma Register of Historic Places, along with the requisite application materials, and

WHEREAS the Landmarks Preservation Commission ("Commission")
reviewed the request on March 26, 2014, and held a public hearing on April 23,
2014, to receive public comment on the historic significance of the Property, and
WHEREAS, according to TMC 13.07.040, the Commission found that the
Property meets the eligibility requirements for listing on the Tacoma Register of
Historic Places, and

WHEREAS, based upon said findings, the City Council believes that it would be in the best interest of the City to designate the Property described below as a historic landmark and place it on the Tacoma Register of Historic Places; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

Section 1. Designation. That, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 13.07 of the Tacoma Municipal Code ("TMC"), the City Council of Tacoma approves the designation of the following Property as a historic landmark and places said property on the Tacoma Register of Historic Places:

(1) Municipal Barn

More particularly described as: 2324 South C Street, Tacoma, WA 98402.

Parcel: 2023060010

That portion of the Northwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 09, Township 20 North, Range 03 East, W.M. more particularly described as follows:

Lots 1 through 5, inclusive, Block 2306 of Map of New Tacoma, Washington Territory as filed for record February 2, 1875, records of Pierce County Auditor.

Together with the easterly 5 feet of Adams Street (now Holgate Street) abutting thereon and attaching there to by operation of law, as vacated by City of Tacoma Ordinance No. 3911.

Situate in the City of Tacoma, County of Pierce, State of Washington; based upon satisfaction of the following standards of TMC 13.07.040:

- A. Is associated with events that have made a significant contribution to the broad patterns of our history;
- C. Embodies the distinctive characteristics of a type, period, or method of construction, or represents the work of a master, or possesses high artistic values, or represents a significant and distinguishable entity whose components may lack individual distinction;
- E. Is part of, adjacent to, or related to an existing or proposed historic district, square, park, or other distinctive area which should be redeveloped or preserved according to a plan based on a historic, cultural, or architectural motif; and

F. Owing to its unique location or singular physical characteristics, represents an established and familiar visual feature of the neighborhood or City.

Section 2. Controls. A Certificate of Approval must be obtained from the Landmarks Preservation Commission, pursuant to TMC 13.05.047 et seq., or the time for denying an application for a Certificate of Approval must have expired before the owner may make alterations or changes to the following property:

1. Municipal Barn: Specifically, changes only to the exterior of the primary structure.
