

ORDINANCE NO. 29039

AN ORDINANCE relating to transportation; adopting the Commute Trip Reduction Four-Year Plan Update: 2025-2029, to outline the City's planned approach to meet Washington State's Commute Trip Reduction requirements.

WHEREAS the City is required, pursuant to RCW 70A.15.4020, to adopt a local Commute Trip Reduction plan ("CTR Plan"), and

WHEREAS under state law, a CTR Plan focuses on reducing vehicle miles travelled, by working with large employers on transportation demand management programs to support and encourage the use of transit, rideshare, and active transportation, and

WHEREAS the Washington State Department of Transportation

("WSDOT") requires local adoption of the 2025-2029 CTR Plan by

June 30, 2025, to remain in compliance with state CTR Plan rules, and maintain eligibility for CTR Plan formula funding from the State, which is approximately \$167,800 per biennium, and

WHEREAS the CTR Plan has been reviewed by and found to be concurrent with requirements by the Puget Sound Regional Council, WSDOT, and the Transportation Demand Management Technical Committee, and a Preliminary Determination of Environmental Nonsignificance was issued under WAC 197-11-340(2) on May 8, 2025, and

WHEREAS additionally, the CTR Plan was presented to the City's Bicycle Pedestrian Technical Advisory Group on April 28, 2025; Now, Therefore,



BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TACOMA:

Section 1. That the City Council hereby adopts the Recitals of this Ordinance as its formal legislative findings.

Section 2. That the Commute Trip Reduction Four-Year Plan Update: 2025-2029, is hereby adopted, said document to be substantially in the form of the document on file in the office of the City Clerk.
