2. <u>16-0147</u> Puyallup Tribe Emerald Queen I-5 Casino Update [Alisa O'Hanlon, Government Relations Coordinator, City Manager's Office]

At approximately 10:05 a.m., Alisa O'Hanlon, City Manager's Office, Andrew Strobel, Eric Guion, and Rob Quaempts, Puyallup Tribe of Indians, provided an update of the Puyallup Tribe of Indians plan to relocate the Emerald Queen (EQ) Casino I-5, including the proposed permanent facility, facility design, parking garage, paved parking and road improvements. Discussion ensued throughout regarding parking stalls in the garage, the existing structure, the music venue, phases in construction, street scape improvements, surrounding businesses, casino standards, the urban area, economics between the current building and the new building, employee count with the new EQ, current employees, new jobs created, and public transit access.
