OVERVIEW



- Substantial amendment to the Tacoma-Lakewood HOME Consortium's 2021-2022 Annual Action Plan
- Required plan outlines the spending plan for American Rescue Plan funds received from the federal Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD)
 - HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME ARP): **\$5,110,825**
- Eligible uses are supportive services, acquisition and development of non-congregate shelters, tenant-based rental assistance, development of affordable rental housing, and administration
- Programs serve individuals and households experiencing homelessness or who are greatest risk of housing instability

- **August 2022** – Allocation Plan is submitted to HUD
- **September 2022** – HUD has 45 days from the submission date to notify the City if plan is approved and funding will be made available

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
