



RESOLUTION NO. 39475

1 A RESOLUTION relating to education and recreation programs; authorizing the
2 execution of an amendment to the interlocal agreement with the
3 Metropolitan Park District of Tacoma, in the amount of \$580,000, for a
4 cumulative contract amount of \$2,320,000; and accepting and depositing
5 said sum into the 2009 LTGO Bond Capital Projects Fund 3218 for the
6 purpose of funding additional improvements to the People's Community
7 Center.

8 WHEREAS People's Community Center ("Center"), a City-owned facility
9 operated by the Metropolitan Park District of Tacoma ("Metro Parks"), was built in
10 the Hilltop neighborhood in 1978, and

11 WHEREAS, in 2008, after an engineering assessment, the Center's pool
12 was closed due to structural concerns, and

13 WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 39150, adopted on March 31, 2015,
14 the City and Metro Parks entered into an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement, in the
15 amount of \$1,740,000, for the purpose of jointly financing a public pool at the
16 Center, and

17 WHEREAS the parties now desire to increase the agreement by the amount
18 of \$580,000, for a cumulative amount of \$2,320,000, to provide for additional
19 improvements at the Center, to include enhancements to the shower/locker rooms,
20 exterior painting, and replacement of the gym roof, and

21 WHEREAS staff recommends entering into said amendment to allow for
22 additional funding by Metro Parks in the amount of \$580,000, for said
23 improvements; Now, Therefore,
