DOG: Continuing public ownership of the telecommunications assets, especially those assets necessary for Tacoma Power operations



DRAGON: Ensuring geographically, economically, and technologically equitable access



GOAT: Creating low-income affordable access to telecommunication services



HORSE: Enforcing net neutrality principles for all customers



MONKEY: Allowing open access to telecommunication assets by other telecommunication providers, to the extent such access benefits customers



RABBIT: Preserving competition among telecommunication providers that benefits customers (such as high-quality, technologically up-to-date, and reasonably priced telecommunication services), including restricting transfer of ownership or operations that reduce competition



OX: Safeguarding the use of telecommunications services by Tacoma Power, the City, and other local governments



RAT: Maintaining financial stability of the telecommunications business operations utilizing the Click! assets



SNAKE: Promoting economic development and educational opportunities



ROOSTER: Providing job options and security for Click! staff and protecting the intellectual capital of the system



TIGER: Protecting customer privacy



PIG: Preserving Click!'s goodwill, including via its market-leading customer service for telecommunications customers
