I apologize for my late comment, but hoping it could still be on the record. I reference to the development off South 21st Street on Commerce Street in downtown Tacoma, I believe that 'Brewery Blocks' is a good name for this area. The name gives appropriate mention to the neighborhoods history, without pretending to be a historic brewery property. The 'Brewery District' is an area specifically comprised of historic buildings in which are former breweries and include Columbia/Heidelberg and Pacific Brewing and Malting, among a few others. The 'Brewery Blocks' development has done a beautiful job in their branding of its development, which includes new construction and extensive remodels of some older building. I would request that the area not be named "Brewery District" or anything misrepresenting the history of adjacent historic properties that truly tell the story of the 'Brewery District'. I believe the appropriate place to have signage for the 'Brewery District' is on the Prairie Line Trail, which runs alongside the historic brewery properties and can communicate and educate that history authentically. The Prairie Line Trail acts as an artery through Tacoma's core, through multiple areas and neighborhoods, from Ruston Waterfront to South Tacoma Way, providing a walk through Tacoma history, public art, and a safe pedestrian path.
