
2023 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN



- Annual component of the City's 2020-2024 Consolidated Plan that sets goals and performance indicators to address housing, homeless, and community development needs
- Outlines the spending plan for 2023 formula allocations:
 - Community Development Block Grants (CDBG): **\$2,393,848**
 - Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG): **\$209,987**
 - HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME): **\$1,458,355**
- Programs serve individuals, households, and business owners who earn 80% or less than Pierce County Area Median Income
- Sub recipient agreements between the City of Tacoma, Tacoma Community Redevelopment Authority (TCRA), City of Lakewood & individual contractors.




