



RESOLUTION NO. 39243

1 A RESOLUTION appointing individuals to committees that will prepare statements
2 "For" and "Against" Initiative No. 1, concerning establishing a minimum
3 wage for the City of Tacoma; Initiative No. 1B, concerning an alternative
4 measure to establishing a minimum wage for the City of Tacoma; Initiative
5 No. 2, concerning changing the form of government, Council composition,
6 and term limits in the City of Tacoma; and Proposition No. 3, concerning
7 street improvements, which will appear in the voters' pamphlet for the
8 General Election to be held November 3, 2015.

9 WHEREAS, on July 14, 2015, the City Council approved Resolution
10 No. 39236, transmitting a ballot measure concerning street improvements to the
11 Pierce County Auditor to be placed on the ballot for the General Election on
12 Tuesday, November 3, 2015, and

13 WHEREAS, on July 14, 2015, the City Council approved Resolution
14 No. 39237, transmitting a ballot measure concerning an alternative measure to
15 establishing a minimum wage for the City of Tacoma to the Pierce County Auditor
16 to be placed on the ballot for the General Election on Tuesday, November 3, 2015,
17 and

18 WHEREAS, on July 21, 2015, the City Council approved Resolution
19 No. 39240, transmitting a ballot measure concerning establishing a minimum wage
20 for the City of Tacoma to the Pierce County Auditor to be placed on the ballot for
21 the General Election on Tuesday, November 3, 2015, following the initiative
22 process as outlined in Section 2.19 of the City Charter, and

23 WHEREAS Initiative No. 2, concerning changing the form of government,
24 Council composition, and term limits in the City of Tacoma, has qualified for and

will appear on the ballot for the General Election on Tuesday, November 3, 2015,

2 WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 29A.32.280, for each measure included in a
3 local voters' pamphlet from a unit of local government, the legislative authority of
4 that jurisdiction shall, not later than 45 days before publication of the pamphlet,
5 formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating voters' approval of
6 the measure and shall formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments
7 advocating voters' rejection of the measure, and

9 WHEREAS, at its meeting of July 15, 2015, the Government Performance
10 and Finance Committee reviewed applications and made recommendations for the
11 appointment of individuals to the "For" and "Against" committees for Initiative No. 1,
12 and

14 WHEREAS, at a special meeting held July 23, 2015, the Government
15 Performance and Finance Committee reviewed applications and made
16 recommendations for the appointment of individuals to the "For" and "Against"
17 committees for Initiative No. 1B, Initiative No. 2, and Proposition No. 3; Now,
18 Therefore,

20 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

22 That the nominees for the "For" and "Against" committees, as listed on the
23 attached Exhibit "A," are hereby confirmed and the persons designated thereon are
24 hereby appointed as committee members of the "For" and "Against" committees for
25 Initiative No. 1, concerning establishing a minimum wage for the City of Tacoma;
26 Initiative No. 1B, concerning an alternative measure establishing a minimum wage
